

Registration and Take Off

Captains from each team must attend a mandatory pre-tournament meeting Saturday, August 3rd, 6:00pm at Remi's Thirsty Moose.

Team take off positions will be assigned at the pre-tournament meeting.

Registration for all boats will take place Sunday, August 4th between 5:30am and 6:30am.

Optional Big Bass Pot

Each boat may pay \$10 at check-in to enter in the Big Bass side pot. All money will be paid to the boat catching heaviest bass. Ties will split money equally.

Optional Big Bag Pot

Each boat may pay \$10 at check-in to enter the big bag pot. All money will be paid out to the boat weighing the heaviest 5 fish limit.

Weigh In-2:00 P.M.

- 5 Bass Limit Per Boat, Large or Smallmouth Bass
- Short Fish Will Result in DQ of Entire Bag
- 1/2 lb. Penalty for Each Dead Fish.

Sportsmanship and Safety

All local and state boating/fishing regulations apply. Live bait or trolling is not allowed.

Team standings will be determined by combining total weight of each boat on a team.

Plaques will be awarded to each angler on the First, Second and Third Place Teams at Awards Ceremony.

Rules

-Every Boat Participating Must Have a Sponsor

- No live bait allowed.
- Each boat must catch and weigh their own catch.
- Each boat must be past check-in boat by 2pm. (2:15 if more than 50 boats)
- No wake under RR trestle.
- Maintain minimum 100' distance from other fishermen. (Including shore fishermen.)
- Wear life jackets when the big motor is running.
- A ribbon for participating boats will be tied to trolling motor.
- You must use weigh-in bags provided by event organizers. A weigh-in slip will be given to you when you pick up your bag.
- Five boats will be allowed to weigh-in at a time. Boats waiting to weigh in must remain on the water unless there is extreme/severe weather conditions.
