LOOKING AHEAD LEADERSHIP COUNCIL AGREEMENT

Transition Policy:

Leadership Council groups are separated by age brackets: 9-11, 12-14 and 15-18. Members who are turning 12 or 15 between now and December 31, 2016 will be placed in the older age group. Members who are turning 12 or 15 on January 1, 2017 or after will remain in the younger age group. Members may <u>not</u> choose what Leadership Council group they are in and cannot change groups during the year. All members must stay in the same Leadership Council group September through May.

Regardless of what Leadership group you belong to, you may only register for Looking Ahead events for your exact age group. For example, if you are turning 12 on December 3rd, you will be in the 12-14 Leadership Council group for the year, but you may only attend other Looking Ahead events for the 9-11 age group until your 12th birthday, when you may begin attending events for the 12-14 age group.

Attendance:

Leadership Council members are expected to maintain good attendance and demonstrate punctuality. Members <u>are not</u> to miss more than <u>three meetings</u> during the academic year (September-May). Leadership Council members must notify Looking Ahead staff in the event of an anticipated absence.

Participation:

To fully benefit from the Looking Ahead Program and Leadership Council, participation in group activities and events is expected. Engaging in discussions and participating in Leadership Council activities openly will help all members reach their full leadership potential. In additional to attending Leadership Council meetings, all members must also attend at least three Looking Ahead events each year, one of which must be a Community Service event.

Respect:

Leadership Council was created as part of the Looking Ahead program to empower young performers to learn, grow, and develop leadership skills in a non-competitive, safe, and supportive environment. Leadership members are expected to demonstrate respect for peers, staff, and parents by actively listening, behaving appropriately, and communicating openly.
