Review of May 23rd Tour

Back on May 23rd, 2011 members from IIE and SME attended a tour of CPI Aerostructures, Inc. The company is a prime contractor to the U.S. Government, whereby they deliver skin panels, leading edges, flight control surfaces, engine components, wing tips, cowl doors, nacelle assemblies and inlet assemblies for military aircraft such as the C-5 "Galaxy" cargo jet, the T-38 "Talon" jet trainer, the C-130 "Hercules" cargo jet, the A-10 "Thunderbolt" or "Warthog" attack jet, and the E-3 "Sentry" AWACS jet. CPI Aero is also a subcontractor to leading defense prime contractors such as Northrop Grumman Corporation, Lockheed Martin Corporation, Sikorsky Aircraft Corporation and Vought Aircraft Industries, Inc. They deliver various pods, and modular and structural assemblies for military aircraft such as the UH-60 "Blackhawk" helicopter, the MH-60S mine counter measure helicopter and the C-5 cargo jet.

What was impressive about this company, which was founded in 1980, was their team approach to servicing their customers and their clean and organized facility as seen in the photo below.



Each work / assembly cell have the names and photos of the participants, including team leaders and the support engineers posted on the communication boards adjacent to the work cell.

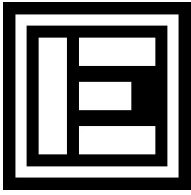
