



Tesoro High School Activities Behavior Contract

2016 – 2017

Both parent/guardian (even if student is 18+) and student must read, understand, initial (8X) and sign this agreement

All students attending Tesoro High School (THS) activities, on or off campus, are expected to know that appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored or supported by THS. Activities include but are not limited to: formal and semi-formal dances, athletic events, senior activities, banquets, pep rallies, performing arts events, camps, field trips, lunch activities, etc. Please refer to Capistrano Unified School District Student Information Handbook for more detailed information and consequences. All students and parents should be aware of the following specifics regarding school activities:

- 1. Students must be dressed appropriately at all times.** This is a district wide dress/grooming standard. Students that are out of compliance with these standards, on the first offense will not be allowed into any dance/activity. Students must always wear shoes, and collared shirts with ties must be worn. On subsequent offenses parents will be contacted to bring appropriate attire or to pick up the student.
These items are NOT allowed.
 - Any items that contains offensive, illegal, violent, obscene symbols, signs, slogans, or words degrading any gender, culture, religion, ethnicity, race, or anything that may incite a negative response or conflict including reference to sex, drugs, alcohol or tobacco.
 - Bare midriffs or clothing with exposes the student's midsection.
 - Sheer/see through blouses, dresses, tops, or skirts.
 - Halter tops, tube tops or tank tops that are excessively revealing. (Strapless dresses are allowed for Homecoming, Winter Formal and Prom.)
 - Tops that hang off the shoulder, reveal undergarments or have deep scoop necks or deep sides.
 - Excessively short shorts or immodest shorts and skirts must meet the "fingertip rule" (arms straight down to the side shorts must be longer than the end of their fingertips).
 - Tight or revealing clothing.
 - Leggings that are worn as pants (must have shirt that covers buttocks).
 - Clothing that allows underwear to be exposed or resembles undergarments (i.e. slips, boxers).
 - Pajamas (tops or bottoms).
 - Excessively baggy pants/sweats (must not have crotch that hangs excessively low or excessive material at the foot and/or drags).
 - Pants must be capable of staying up around the waist without a belt.
 - Clothing which is ripped, frayed or torn excessively.
 - Footwear: no bare feet, no slippers, no rubber flip flops, combat type boots and/or steeled toes.
 - Jewelry/Accessories: hats, beanies, hooded sweatshirt (worn with hood on), dangerous jewelry (including spiked or dangerous collars), chains, wallet chains, hair-nets, gang related symbols, untied or dangling belts, safety pins or sharp objects in clothes or pierced skin.
 - Hair styles or hair coloring that is disruptive or has letters, messages or unusual designs/symbols shaved into head.
 - Jeans, shorts, canes, chains, or hats at formal dances.**Student's Initials _____ Parent's Initials _____**
- 2. All students must have a Tesoro High School ID Card.** Students are expected to carry THS ID card with them on campus during school hours and at all school events/activities. When asked by a staff member, students must present their ID card immediately. Students are expected to keep their card in acceptable shape and not alter their card in any way. If a student loses the card he/she may purchase a replacement at the Activities Office.

- 3. No profanity/vulgarity.** Students are expected to use appropriate language and refrain from gestures that are obscene or vulgar while at school or during school events and activities.

- 4. All students are responsible for the cleanliness of the campus.** A student is considered to have littered if he/she leaves an area when trash has been left, whether or not it is his/her trash. Throwing food (or any object) is never acceptable. It is expected that students clean up after themselves, walk to a trashcan and drop trash into can. This includes biodegradable items.

- 5. Any vehicle, including limousines, may be searched.** All passengers in a vehicle are responsible for any illegal substance in the vehicle.

- 6. No use of alcohol, controlled substance, tobacco or intoxicant of any kind.** According to Board Policy 5144.1 "students are to be recommended by the school principal for expulsion if they are found: possessing, using, distributing or being under the influence of any controlled substance, alcohol beverage, or intoxicant of any kind." The minimum consequence is a 5-day suspension and the loss of all student privileges for 2 semesters (i.e. participation in all extracurricular activities, co-curricular activities/privileges, on-campus parking, and senior activities and commencement ceremony, if applicable).

- 7. All students must be respectful.** Any student whose behavior adversely affects the experience of another participant or performer (i.e. heckling, shouting, use of racial or other inappropriate epithets and slurs, rude audience etiquette, etc.) or damages property at any event will face consequences which may include suspension and/or exclusion from any school related activities.

8. **Dances.** In order to promote a healthy, safe enjoyable evening for all students, the following procedures will be in place for this dance: There is no admittance to the dance after the first hour unless prior arrangements have been made with the Activities Director. No student will be permitted to leave the dance before designated time set by administration. Attendees who leave the dance will not be readmitted. If a student is removed from the dance for any reason, it is the parent's responsibility to immediately pick up the student from the dance. Students will be breathalyzed and searched. Please Read & Understand that the **Dance Dress Code is STRICTLY Enforced***

*The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dress style. Questions/complaints about dress code will NOT be addressed at the dance. Student in violation of dress code will NOT be admitted into the dance. Students who are dressed inappropriately will be asked to call home for a change of clothes or must be picked up. If your dress is in question, send a picture of you in the dress to Ms. Johnson (dijohnson@capousd.org) in the Administration office for approval prior to the dance.

Any vehicle may be searched. ALL passengers in a vehicle will be held responsible for any illegal substance found in that vehicle. All party busses and limousines will be searched. If your group has 12 or more people, you will need to turn in a group transportation clearance form to the ASB office at least three days prior to dance.

Attendees may be checked for possession and/or consumption of illegal or controlled substances prior to entry and on the dance area. Security may conduct purse searches, "pat downs" and/or substance consumption field tests. Any attendee who refuses to comply will be denied entry.

Each student must present a **Tesoro High School ID card at the Dance Check-In table.**

All dance styles must comply with standards of modesty and safety. Inappropriate dancing or other sexually suggestive behavior is inappropriate and will result in removal from the dance (temporarily or permanently). The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dance style. 1st offense, student will be given an immediate 15 minute time out and a detention. 2nd offense, student will be removed from the dance, (parent must pick them up) and student will also lose future privileges (i.e. will not be able to walk in graduation; will not be able to attend future dances).

Tickets refunds **will not be issued the day of the dance or any time after.** Tickets may not be sold or transferred to another student.

Guests must be approved by administration. A separate guest contract must be filled out. Please know that all visiting guests (Winter Formal and Prom only) must abide by Tesoro Students rules/dress code/dance behavior etc. and the Tesoro student is ultimately responsible for their guest at all times. Guests must provide the same identification that was submitted with their guest ticket contract. Tesoro students bringing a guest to Winter Formal or Prom must check in with their guest.
