


• Students will only be permitted to travel with Jazz House staff and chaperones during off campus activities.

**In the event of an emergency**, if a child appears to need immediate medical attention, Jazz House Kids staff will contact 911. We reserve the right to request medical attention for any situation that is perceived as an emergency by Jazz House Kids faculty or staff.

If a student is sick, and the parents refuse medical care, the parents must pick up their child within 12 hours.

### Jazz House Summer Workshop

## **RESIDENT RULES**

- 1. Participants are not allowed to drive or ride in personal vehicles during the dates of the program unless they receive specific permission to do so from the Workshop Director or Workshop Manager. Any vehicles parked on campus must have a University Parking Permit (CarParc Diem lot-Montclair State University). Parking permits will be issued during on-site registration, and clear instructions will be given as to where parking is authorized. It will be the responsibility of the participant to purchase a permit, properly place the permit in the vehicle, and park the vehicle in an authorized space. Neither Montclair State University, nor Jazz House Kids, will be responsible for damage to vehicles or for any parking tickets, fines, or towing charges that result from violations.
- 2. Participants are to remain on campus for the duration of the program unless program activities require otherwise. If a participant needs to leave campus for some reason, Camp Directors must receive prior written permission from the parent or guardian, and grant specific permission on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. Jazz House Kids and Montclair State University campus regulations prohibit the use of alcohol and other illegal substances. Participants may not possess, use, distribute, or sell alcoholic beverages, drugs, firearms, weapons or fireworks. Any student that is found in the possession of any alcohol or illegal substances will face grounds of immediate expulsion from the Jazz House Kids Summer Workshop.
- 4. Co-ed visitation in the residence halls is permitted **ONLY** in the lobby area, under the supervision of a chaperone. The only people permitted in rooms are staff, members of the participant's immediate family, the participant's roommate and other participants of the same gender residing in that residence hall. **Any Student that is found in violation of the co-ed visitation rules will face grounds of immediate expulsion from the Jazz House Kids Summer Workshop.**
- 5. Participants must attend all workshops, classes, and planned social or recreational activities. Full participation is the only way a participant can gain real value from the workshop. Students are not permitted to return to Machuga Heights during the day unless accompanied by a chaperone.
- 6. Participants will refrain from using electronic devices (i.e. cell phones, iPads, computers, etc.) during instructional periods unless authorized by workshop faculty and staff.

### **RESIDENT RULES continued**

- 7. Participants will abide by nightly curfews and "Lights Out" announcements from the Housing Supervisor or Program Chaperones. Participants must be in their OWN room at lights out and remain there until morning. Any use of cell phones or other electronic devices is prohibited after 'Lights Out.' Curfew is at 10:00PM (unless there is a scheduled activity that exceeds the 10:00PM time schedule), and lights out is strictly at 11:00PM.
- 8. Participants must never misuse Internet privileges. Attempting to access unauthorized sites is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Participants must abide by rules and guidelines set by the Jazz House Kids Housing Supervisor for each day of stay of the Workshop. Guidelines and policies explained in Welcome Package 1 are to remain in effect.
- 10. In accordance with state law, smoking is prohibited by anyone under the age of 21. Smoking is not permitted in any buildings on the Montclair State University Campus.
- 11. Any individual found tampering with any fire equipment (i.e. fire extinguishers, fire alarms, smoke detectors, etc.) will be dismissed from the workshop immediately. Participants may not interfere with any security system or tamper with locks in participants' rooms and other areas.
- 12. All furniture must remain unchanged and kept in place.
- 13. Vandalism will not be permitted. Any damages caused in rooms or common areas will be charged to the responsible party. Replacement cost will be charged to anyone who removes or damages University property.
- 14. Participants should keep their rooms locked at all times. Neither Montclair State University, nor Jazz House Kids, is responsible for lost or stolen items. A participant should take the room key and access card whenever he/she is leaving the room. Those who lose a key or access card must pay for a replacement (Key replacement amount is \$75.00 and Access Card replacement fee is \$50.00). Please refrain from bringing excess money and valuables to the workshop. Valuables, including jewelry, iPods, cell phones, radios, cd players, etc., may be brought to camp, but only at participant's own risk.



## **RESIDENT RULES continued (2)**

- 15. Montclair State University housekeeping staff will not clean the bathrooms. Students will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their shared bathroom space.
- 16. For health and security reasons, camp staff has right to inventory students' belongings if the staff indicates the need.
- 17. Practicing is allowed in the lounges of Machuga Heights at a minimal level. No music will be played after 10:00PM.
- 18. No disturbingly loud noises, belligerence, wrestling, or fighting is allowed at ANY time.
- 19. Any conflict with another student, adult, or student/staff member of Montclair State University is to be immediately directed to the Housing Manager.

IMPORTANT: Jazz House Kids has a ZERO tolerance for fighting, practical jokes, bullying, cyber bullying, sexist comments, racist comments, or any other derogatory remarks towards ANYONE. Failure to follow this rule will result in grounds for immediate termination.





## Jazz House Summer Workshop Discipline Policy

As stated in our Camp Guidelines and Policies, it is our full expectation that all students will behave in a manner that respects themselves, this great music and their peers to ensure a super camp experience! We have specific disciplinary action steps in place if students do not adhere to these guidelines and policies. If there should be any issues with a student's behavior, we have a 3-step policy for handling such situations.

### **3 STEP DISCIPLINARY ACTION PROCESS**

### Step 1. Verbal Warning:


The student will receive a verbal warning from an instructor or administrator. The Camp Office will be notified of the incident.

### Step 2. Report to Camp Office:

The student will be sent to the Camp Office to meet with camp managers to discuss the incident and possible discipline. The student's parents will be notified.

### Step 3. Parent conference and possible removal from Workshop

The student and parents will be called for an in-person conference. If no resolution is found, the student may be removed from the remainder of the workshop. Should this occur, there will be no refund.

## Jazz House Summer Workshop Homestay Frequently Asked Questions

#### Will there be security in Machuga Heights?

- Montclair State University provides 24 hour on-site security with access to EMS and Campus Police. In addition, Machuga Heights can only be entered with an access card which students will be given individually at orientation.
- There will always be a Jazz House Kids chaperone staff on-site.

#### Will students be able to travel with other families off campus?

• No, students are not permitted to travel with other families UNLESS that student's parent or legal guardian gives full consent verbally or via email to Jazz House Kids.

#### Who can I talk to in the case of an emergency?

- In the case of a medical emergency, the Montclair State University Public Safety office can be contacted.
- In the case of any non-medical emergencies, the Jazz House Kids Summer Jazz Workshop Housing Manager can be contacted.

#### Will my son/daughter be allowed to choose his/her roommate?

• Students who wish to have a specific roommate should contact the Jazz House no later than July 30<sup>th</sup>. If there is not a specification of room assignments, one will be chosen by the Jazz House staff.

## Will my son/daughter be allowed to change their room assignment once camp starts?

• No, all rooming assignments will be established before camp begins. Any extenuating circumstances will be given full consideration on a case-by-case basis.



#### Will students be allowed to bring game systems?

 Jazz House Kids encourages ALL Resident students to leave important personal items at home. However, any personal item that is brought to camp is done at every individuals OWN RISK. Neither Montclair State University nor Jazz House Kids will assume the responsible for any personal items (stolen, broken, or lost).

#### Can students have snacks in their rooms?

• Yes, students are permitted to have snacks in their rooms but must clean up after themselves.
