

One cost for the duration of the show. VEHICLE - One vehicle per site unless it is a large truck and car comes with it as daily transport. Each vehicle will be issued with a non-transferable permit. You must provide a mobile phone number on this application - NO MOBILE PHONE NUMBER - NO PERMIT. SIZE OF VEHICLE - This is important, as it assists with ensuring you will fit on your allocated site. Please provide accurate measurements. WRISTBANDS - On arrival, each exhibitor will surrender their gate passes and be issued with a plastic wristband to be worn 24 hours per day. Security will be on hand to check that campers are wearing wristbands and that their vehicles have a camping permit affixed to their windscreen. If you are accompanied by someone who does not have an exhibitor's pass, that person will be required to pay for a gate pass for the number of public days they are staying at the Show. That's \$20 per adult Friday, \$20 for Sunday and \$20 for Sunday. ACCESS - The wristbands and the vehicle permit will allow you access in and out of the Showground for the duration of the Show. ELECTRICITY - All electrical cords must be elevated at least 3m above the ground. Any person intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be requested to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. Double adaptors and piggy back plugs must not be used on power supply outlets at any time. The RNCAS or it's representative shall have the right to disconnect any electrical apparatus that may be deemed unsafe or may be overloading service lines feeding said apparatus. Please check all your electrical equipment before you come to the Showground to avoid difficulties. FENCES - Fencing of Show animals in Camping Area is strictly prohibited. Exhibitors intending to pen animals near their campsite must seek permission from the Camping Supervisor prior to setting up camp. FIRE BAN - No camp fires permitted at any time. SULLAGE DISPOSAL - All waste water (sullage) must be disposed of at approved facilities. If there is no sewer access then waste water must be stored in large containers with tight fitting lids and arrangements made to empty them. No waste water is to be deposited into stormwater drains or onto grass or paved areas. CANCELLATIONS - Site bookings cancelled up to 27 January 2010 will receive a 75% refund of all moneys paid. No refunds will be given for bookings cancelled after this date. CONFIRMATION - Confirmation of your site will be in writing and sent out in the first week in February 2010. I fully understand and accept the above conditions and agree to abide by them. Signed
