
GRACIE & SPRING STILL WAITING FOR THEIR FOREVER HOME!!

HOT ASPHALT HURTS!



This is probably an obvious tip but one that folks sometimes don't consider enough. It's a great idea to take your dog out on daily walks, but be mindful of when and where you walk him. The best time to walk your dog is in the morning or late evening, when the pavement is cool. Avoid walking your dog in the afternoon when the sun is high in the sky or early evening, because the

pavement will be hot.

You may also want to use protective gear or paw waxes to protect you dogs feet even more.

LET'S GET THOSE DOGS HOME, FAST!

Morning Starr is keeping our Microchipping costs down to \$15 in order to get those dogs home faster! So many dogs are brought to the Humane Societies and it takes a long time to get them reunited with their owners, which sometimes never happens. If you are reunited then you usually have to pay fines that can be much more than if you had them microchipped. Dogs are stressed in the whole process. We use Petlink Microchips which is a \$15 one time fee for the life of the dog. If your dog is microchipped make sure information is updated regularly. Call to make an appointment with us to get your dog Microchipped!
