Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Barcelona Trip - July 2017

We would like to invite your son/daughter to visit Barcelona, Spain. The visit will take place from Friday 14 July-Wednesday 19 July. This will be a great opportunity for your son/daughter to develop their independence and practise using their Spanish outside the classroom.

The trip will allow the students to benefit from the opportunity to visit Barcelona and its numerous attractions. We will be visiting Barcelona's many landmarks such as The Gothic Quarter, Parc Guell, The Boqueria Market and many more. A guided tour visit to La Sagrada Familia (Gaudi's master piece), a flamenco lesson, and a visit to the Tibidabo theme park have been included in the price package.

We will be travelling by coach. The accommodation, which is shared rooms and full board, has been verified by our very experienced travel agency, but students will need to provide their own food for the outward journey. Once in Barcelona we shall be exploring the city mostly on foot.

The cost of the visit will be £475, plus students might like to take an additional amount of spending money for souvenirs, etc. The price is based on 30 students taking part - if more students participate then there will be a £20 reduction in price, which will be reflected in a reduced final instalment. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals the school will be able to offer a 20% reduction in the total cost of the trip. If you wish your son/daughter to take part in this visit, a deposit of £50 (£40 if your child receives Free School Meals) will be required **by Thursday 6**th **October**, which is **non-refundable** if the trip goes ahead.

Please pay the deposit and all further instalments (detailed below) via WisePay, and return the consent form to the school office. You may also pay the full amount in advance by WisePay if you wish to do so.

Instalment amounts to be paid via WisePay are as follows:

Deposit due by 6th October: £50 (£40 for Free School students)

28th October: £85 (£68 for FSM students)
28th November £85 (£68 for FSM students)
28th February: £85 (£68 for FSM students)
28th March £85 (£68 for FSM students)
28th April £85 (£68 for FSM students)

Total Amount due = £475 (£380 for FSM students)















Your son/daughter will require his/her own passport and EHIC (European health Insurance Card) in order to travel. Passports, EHIC cards and any visas required for travel must be obtained by you. We remain part of the European Union for at least the next 2 years and thus a British European Union passport will not require a visa (according to current advice).

We expect the highest standards of behaviour from our students on the trip and any student with a place on the trip who receives a significant number of consequences prior to the trip will forfeit their place.
