Mentorship Program 2016: Guidelines & Responsibilities: Mentee

SPECIFIC TO RISE UP PROGRAM, ROUND 2:

- Mentors and mentees agree to a 3-month commitment.
- During this 3-month period, the minimum requirements are to meet one-on-one, once a month and email once a week. This can be as flexible as both sides are comfortable with.
- Life happens, and sometimes obligations need to be rearranged.
 Please give your partner the respect of at least 24 hours cancellation notice prior to your scheduled meeting.
- This is not considered an internship, nor guarantee of employment.
- The mentees of this first round can give back by participating as the mentors to University level students in the second round.
- AIGA Mentorship Committee will hand select the pairs based on the application, geographic proximity, professional interests and outside interests.
 Understand and respect your Mentor's boundaries regarding
- The program is only open to AIGA members at the contributing level and above.
- There is an application fee of \$25 for all mentees after acceptance into the program. Participation is free for mentors, but the application process is still a requirement.
- There will be a mandatory launch party on January 23rd where mentees and mentors will meet "officially" for the first time.
- There will be a survey at the end of the 3-month process in order to optimize the experience.
- There will be a closing party on Saturday, April 23rd at the end of the 3-month process with mandatory attendance.
- If using social media to detail this experience, use hashtag #AIGARiseup.

MENTEE:

- Mentees often ask their mentors for guidance on portfolios, grad school advice, and career direction advice.
- Establish a regular time and place for meeting.
- Be vocal about your goals, struggles, interests.
- You are responsible for being engaged, respectful, and self-motivated.
- It is your responsibility to take ownership of the learning experience. Challenge yourself by establishing a plan and setting achievable goals.
- Don't be afraid to follow up if you have not heard from your Mentor in a while.
- Understand and respect your Mentor's boundaries regarding the time he/she is willing to commit as well as preferred means of communication.
- One application per person, per program year until you are accepted or no longer meet the requirements.

MENTEE QUALIFICATIONS

- Mentee positions are open to both students and young professionals (3-5+ years experience).
- Mentee positions are open to AIGA members at the contributing level and above.
