





Q4 1. Is there merit in consolidating the legislative framework for building sector regulation and control in one part of the EP&A Act?





Q5 2. Are there sufficient additional benefits to justify consolidating all building legislation (including the Home Building Act 1993) in its own Act?





Q6 3. Are there sufficient benefits to justify the consolidation of building regulation administration?






















Q29 26. Would the following provide a quicker way to discipline certifiers?



Q30 27. Would you prefer an online system for the lodgement of complaints? (The current system is paper-based.)












