

6.2 Authorize the Superintendent to execute a lease agreement with Midwest Transit to continue housing the district's Transportation Department

BACKGROUND

6.1 The Transportation Director advertised for the receipt of fuel bids for the 2014-2015 school year. Those bids were due in the Transportation Department at 10:00 a.m. on July 30, 2014. One bid was received. A review and analysis of the bid was conducted by the Transportation Director. Based on this analysis and the consideration of all factors involved, Folk Oil will continue to serve the best interests of the district.

6.2 For the past year, through a lease agreement, Midwest Transit has housed the district's Transportation Department. The first year of the agreement has worked well for both the district and Midwest Transit. The Board is being asked to authorize the superintendent to execute an agreement with Midwest Transit to continue leasing its facility for the district's Transportation Department.
