- 3. Know that there are no right or wrong answers, just your answers that you have to believe in.
- 4. Know that the judges are real people, nice people, and a little nervous too.
- 5. Have your own answers.
- 6. Make sure you allow the judges time to get the correct interview form in front them.
- 7. Don't wear too much makeup; you will be in close proximity of the judges.
- 8. Be sure to make eye contact with each judge, smile and GOOD LUCK!
