Instructor: Susan Hofrichter, CEBS The coverage of health care benefits begins with a discussion of the environment of health care and health care plans, followed by health plan designs and cost-control techniques. The course also covers the managed care spectrum and managed care plans, as well as maintaining and improving employee health. Dental plans and specialized benefits—behavioral health, prescription drugs, vision, and hearing care plans—also are covered as is the timely topic of consumer-driven health plans, including health reimbursement accounts and health savings accounts. CERTIFIED EMPLOYEE BENEFIT SPECIALIST (CEBS) PROGRAM

The CEBS program offers benefits and compensation professionals several levels of certification, all stamped with the CEBS mark of excellence. The body of knowledge within the CEBS program focuses on group benefits, retirement, and compensation. Each track delivers specialized knowledge in its own unique area and leads to a specialty designation following completion of the required number of courses. When combined, the three tracks form a comprehensive, integrated curriculum in total compensation. To earn the prestigious CEBS credential, candidates must complete eight courses - six required and two elective.

Who Enrolls in CEBS?

Individuals participating in the CEBS program represent all sectors of the total compensation industry-plan sponsors, consulting firms, HMOs, insurance companies, banks, hospitals, administration, investment, labor organizations, public employers, and professional associations dealing with employee benefits.

Textbook Information

Tuition does not include the text book required for the course offered on this brochure or the CEBS exam. All textbooks, study materials, and exams must be ordered directly from the CEBS Department of the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans or a book seller of your choice. Allow 10-14 days for shipment of study materials.

Specialty Designations

To earn a specialty designation, candidates must complete the required courses within each track. All of the specialty track courses may also be applied toward earning the CEBS designation. **New students** who are registering for a CEBS exam must also register with the CEBS Foundation, forms and fees can be found on the CEBS web site.
