Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF)

CWF is a nine-day trip for 4-H youth in grades 10, 11 and 12. The trip provides a setting to experience leadership and citizenship in a whole different way at the National 4-H Conference Center. Youth who have participated in previous trips have returned to report that it has been a highlight of their 4-H career.

Participants can select either June 6 - 14, or June 13 - 21, 2014 to attend the trip. 4-H'ers and adult chaperones travel by chartered bus from Iowa to Washington D.C. Some highlights of the trip are: Flight 93 Memorial, Gettysburg Battlefield, Capitol Hill, Smithsonian Museums, and Mount Vernon. Beside tours and workshops, time is built in for socializing and meeting new friends.

Cost of the trip is \$1,535. This includes lodging, transportation, tour site admissions, and most meals. Registration and a \$475.00 deposit will be required to secure a spot. Fundraising opportunities and financial support through the Pocahontas County 4-H Endowment will be available for participants. Space is limited. Registration deadline is December 15, 2013. Pioneer Grant Applications



The objective of these grants is to stimulate local 4-H clubs in Iowa to plan and carry out community improvement activities by providing "seed money" needed to make the projects successful. Pioneer will provide up to \$10,000, with grants amounts ranging from a minimum of \$50 to a maximum of \$500, to the selected 4-H clubs in Iowa. Awards will be made directly to the clubs through the Iowa 4-H Foundation from Pioneer as soon as selections are made.

Local clubs should fill out the application using the Information & Tips sheets. All application materials should be submitted to the county Extension office by, or before, **October 15**.
