2017 Scholarship Criteria

Eligibility Requirements

The applicant must meet all of the following criteria;

- Be a college bound high school senior at the time of filing the application.
- Be attending college for the first time in the fall of 2017.
- Be enrolled in either a two or four year accredited educational institution.
- Agree to use the scholarship funds awarded only at an accredited educational institution.

Application Process Requirements

Eligible applicants must complete all sections of the scholarship application. Please refer to the checklist before mailing.

#1. The signed application must be submitted along with the following information:
An official high school transcript documenting student's GPA (2.5 or higher)
3 x 5 picture of yourself
Complete typed essay with all questions answered
(2) typed letters of recommendation; one from a school official and one from a community
representative
