This is a juried event. Application materials must be **postmarked by April 30th** to be eligible for jury review. Artists will be contacted mid-May with jury results. Work will be rejected if we suspect that it is not produced by you or if the work is likely to be objectionable to a large percentage of our family audience.

Our jurors decision is final. If your work is not accepted your check will be returned.
