

# Leslie Yates Memorial Coolest Ride & Tie and Biathlon October 13th, 2012

*All proceeds will be donated to the Leslie Yates Ride and Tie Mentorship Fund*

## 23, 14 and 4 mile Ride and Tie Courses 18 mile Biathlon Course (9 mi run, 9 mi ride, 2 people)

**WHERE:** Olmstead Staging Area, Cool, CA. This course is on the Beautiful Olmstead Knickerbocker trail that includes views of Sierra Nevada. Trail varies from single track to fire road, mostly rolling with a few of short/medium climbs - ranging in difficulty from easy to moderate.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Sacramento I-80 going East: in Auburn, take Elm Exit, Turn L at stop light, one block, L on High St (hwy 49). Follow signs to Cool (6 mi). Right, St. Florain Ct. Olmstead Staging Area is behind the Fire Station.

**CAMPING:** Olmstead Staging Area. As of now, no tent is camping allowed so you'll need to sleep in your trailer. This may change so feel free to check in with us at a later time regarding tents.

**CHECK IN:** Friday – arrive anytime. Check in starts at 2 pm. Vetting – Friday: when vet arrives, usually around 4:30 PM, Saturday morning starting at 6:30AM

**POTLUCK:** Friday night at 6pm. Bring your favorite dish! Amazing prize given for best dish, judged by race directors.

**STARTING TIMES:** Ride Meeting: 7:45 am. Biathlon: 8:00 am, 23 mi: 8:15 am, 14 mi: 8:30 am, 4 mi: 12 N

**CREW:** all vet checks are at race camp, Olmstead Staging Area

**LUNCH/AWARDS:** After races. Lots of great food and prizes!

**RAIN?** The County Parks Department requires that we cancel the ride if it rains. **It is your responsibility to see if the ride is on.** Please e-mail or call Carrie Barrett or Sue Smyth the Thursday before the ride - we usually make a decision that morning if the weather has been questionable.

### **Important!**

- Olmstead staging area has a day fee of \$10 per day, be sure to pay or risk getting a ticket. You do not need to pay this if you pay the camping fee; the day fee is for those who only come for the day.
- Please clean up your camp - All manure and hay must be bagged and taken home with you. We will provide bags.
- All dogs must be leashed – the park rangers usually cruise by and check!
- This ride is property that is open to the public. You may see hikers, bikers, riders, dog walkers, etc! Please be courteous to other users – if the Park receives complaints, we won't be able to come back
