Point System for Selection of NHS Members

- All Hart High School students with a Cumulative Academic GPA of 3.5 or above are eligible for consideration.
- 64 points are possible. Candidates must have 48 or more points to be eligible for invitation to membership.
- The following criteria will be used to grant points to each student:

I. Scholarship: I VERIFY THIS WITH THE REGISTRAR

16 points will be granted each student whose Cumulative Academic GPA in standard (not remedial or modified) curriculum is 3.5 or higher. Students MUST receive these 16 points to be eligible for membership! This is verified by the advisor.

II. Service: (The same activities cannot be counted as both Service AND Leadership!)

Maximum 24 points. Points will be granted as follows:

- 2 points per semester or 4 points per year per activity. Short-term service may be awarded 1 or more points at the discretion of the Faculty Council.
- Points will be granted for participation in Sports, ASB, Band, Drama, or other school activities if advisor will document student's participation as a service to the school. (Winter sports count for ONLY one semester.)
- Points will be granted for participation in school-affiliated clubs and organizations (SADD, FBLA, Key Club, CSF, etc.) if advisor will document student's participation as service to school and/or community. (CSF members must tutor or serve on the tutoring committee to qualify.) **MERE MEMBERSHIP IS NOT SERVICE. ADVISOR MUST DOCUMENT PARTICIPATION AS SERVICE!**
- Points will be granted for participation in community organizations if advisor/supervisor will document student's participation as a community service. (Outside documents should be on letterhead.)
- Verification documents signed by parents will NOT be accepted.
- Points may be awarded for awards and honors at the discretion of the Faculty Council. Accepted awards/honors may receive 1 point each up to a maximum of 4 points.
(Submit pictures or photocopies of awards, plaques, or trophies – the ACTUAL award, plaque, or trophy will NOT be accepted.)
- Jobs or work experiences for which the student is paid are NOT to be considered as falling in the category of service.

III. Character: I VERIFY THIS WITH TEACHERS, COUNSELORS AND ADMINISTRATORS

8 points. Character rating will be determined by a faculty/counselor survey. Students MUST receive these 8 points to be eligible for consideration. This is verified by the advisor.

IV. Leadership: (The same activities cannot be counted as both service AND leadership!)

Maximum 16 points. Students MUST receive at least 1 point to be considered for membership!!!!

Points will be granted as follows:

- Club Officers and Team Captains will receive 2 points per semester or 4 points per year. Advisors must verify.
- Documented Leadership in community organizations will receive 4 points per year or 2 points per half-year. Advisors/supervisors must verify on organization letterhead.
Verification documents signed by parents will NOT be accepted.
- Short-term leadership (less than a semester or half-year) may be granted 1 or more points at the discretion of the Faculty Council. Again, advisors/supervisors must verify. Verification documents signed by parents will NOT be accepted.

Do not include ANY information from activities for THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR. It will NOT count. (You may include activities from last summer.)

All information on this form will be used by the Faculty Council to assist with the selection process. Completion of this form does NOT guarantee selection. Forms submitted AFTER the deadline will NOT be considered.

****To guarantee accuracy, all activities MUST be accompanied by verifying documents signed by advisors, supervisors, or coaches. Documents from off-campus should be written on letterheads of appropriate organizations. Students themselves are responsible for obtaining these verifying documents; Faculty Council and Chapter Advisor will NOT make verifying phone calls or inquiries.**

All decisions on membership bids are made by the Faculty Council, and the Faculty Council's decision will be final. If a candidate for membership feels unfairly denied, he or she may request an information meeting with the Chapter Advisor. If the Chapter Advisor feels that the Faculty Council has overlooked anything, the Advisor will ask the Council to reconsider. The Faculty Council, and NOT THE CHAPTER ADVISOR, however, will have the FINAL DECISION on selection for membership. Appeals MAY be made to the principal.

A student who is offered membership will NOT become a member until he or she has signed a statement agreeing to abide by the chapter's bylaws, paid yearly dues, and attended the induction ceremony. Membership in National Honor Society is an honor, not a right.

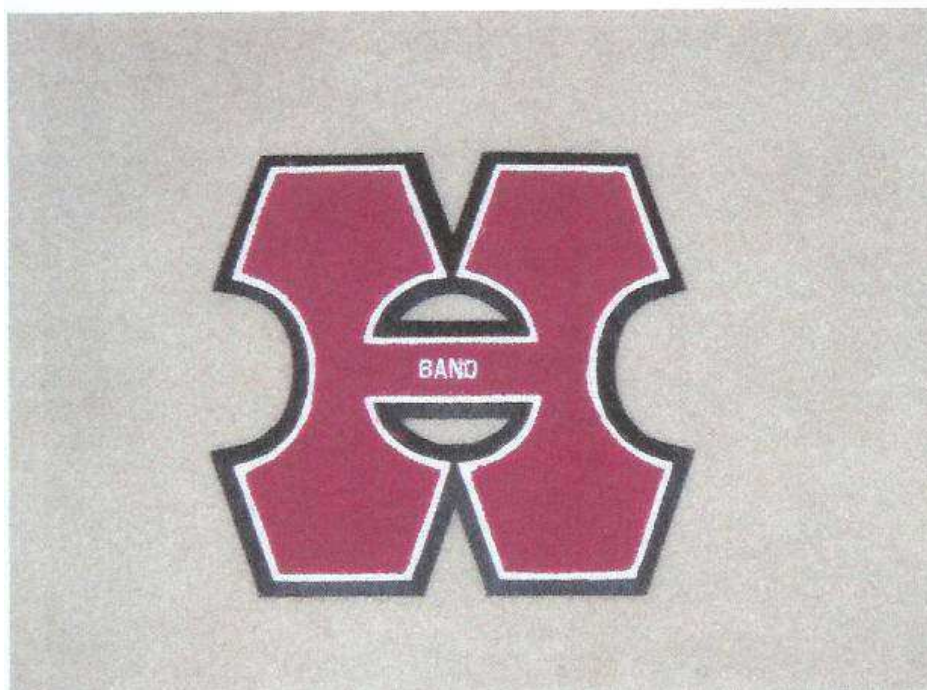
