Applicant/Contractor must order a debris box through Republic Services at (510) 657-3500 or mybluedumpster.com

- Republic Services will deliver one construction debris box to the jobsite for all the debris material, including garbage and recycling.
- If site conditions permit, single commodity debris boxes may be used for specific phases of construction (i.e., clean concrete or clean wood) to ensure the highest recycling rate possible.
- Republic Services will deliver the debris box to the Fremont Recycling and Transfer Station.

**With some exceptions:* Separate loads of clean soil, asphalt, or concrete are not required to be hauled by Republic Services. However, each load cannot contain more than 10% garbage or other non-recyclable material by weight or volume.

Contractors can **self-haul** construction debris from the site, if all these conditions are met:

- Contractor is providing a construction or demolition service on-site and the debris removal is an incidental part of the work performed; and
- Contractors use their own employees, company vehicles and equipment; and
- Contractors use their own employees, company vehicles and equipment; and
- City of origin must say "FREMONT"
- Contractors must list an approved recycling facility (see list)
