### Scope of application form

On and after 1 October 2016, the importation of an asbestos-containing product is prohibited unless authorised by a permit, or imported solely for the purpose of export and is subject to the control of Customs (as defined in section 20 of the Customs and Excise Act 1996) at all times while it is in New Zealand.

A payment of \$650 (excluding GST) must be paid in full to the EPA when an asbestos-containing product import permit application is lodged. Should the assessment of the application take longer than 2.5 hours, or is likely to take longer than 2.5 hours, the applicant will be charged an additional assessing fee of \$116 for each additional hour worked. A proportion of this fee may be charged for part hours. Prior notification of any additional charges will be made in writing.

Asbestos- containing Products	means goods that contain asbestos.
Alternative	in relation to an asbestos-containing product, means goods that –
non-asbestos products	<ul><li>a. fulfil the same purpose as the asbestos-containing product; but</li><li>b. do not contain asbestos</li></ul>
Risk of exposure	means the risk to human health of exposure to asbestos that might reasonably be expected to result from the use of an asbestos-containing product
