

Statutory Declaration Renewal of Driver's Licence

This statutory declaration is to be completed only for the renewal of a Western Australian driver's licence when the applicant cannot produce one of the acceptable forms of primary identification (please see overleaf for acceptable forms of identification for the renewal of a Western Australian driver's licence). Applicants must also provide one form of secondary identification.

This declaration is to be completed by a referee who:

- has known the applicant for a period of 12 months or more;
- is not a relative of the applicant; and
