PURPOSE OF FORM:

To file an information return with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), Farm Bureau Life Insurance Company of Michigan (Farm Bureau Life) must obtain your correct Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

The Taxpayers Relief Act of 1997 requires Farm Bureau Life to backup withhold Federal Income Tax from payments made to businesses and individuals for which Farm Bureau Life does not have a correct TIN on file. A business which, or an individual who, does not provide us with this information may be subject to a penalty imposed by the Internal Revenue Service under Section 6723.
