"A-G" Subjects

In order to satisfy the A-G requirements a grade of "C" or higher must be earned in each area.

- A History/Social Science**
2 Years: 1 year World History
1 year US History and/or US Government
- B English**
4 Years
- C Math**
3 Years: Integrated Math I, II, and III
- D Lab Science**
2 Years: Biology and Chemistry or Physics
- E World Language**
2 Years: Must be two years of the same language
- F Visual Performing Art**
1 Year
- G College Prep Elective**
1 Year
(Any additional "a-f" class subject will satisfy requirement. Exceptions: VAPA must be at the non-introductory level; and language other than English must be third year.)

Benchmarks

- Enroll in SUHSD in the 7th grade and maintain enrollment throughout high school in the SUHSD (beginning with class of 2017). This includes students in the Chula Vista, San Ysidro and South Bay school districts. Starting with the class of 2019 only the Chula Vista Elementary School District Charter Schools listed will qualify: Discovery Charter School, Feaster Charter School and Howard Gardner Community School.
- Attain a CSU GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Complete the A-G requirements (with a C or better)
- Satisfy the Entry Level Math placement test (ELM)
- Satisfy the Entry Level English placement test (EPT)
- Take the SAT Reasoning or ACT test
