Full-length manuscript must be 5,000-7,500 words and conform to APA style. Extended abstract should be 500-1,000 words. No information identifying the author and his or her university affiliation may appear in the submitted manuscript or abstract. Any submissions that fail to conform to this requirement will not be considered.

Up to two submissions from the same individual noted as lead author will be considered. Submissions that explore theoretical and/or critical issues related to the study of communication and sport are invited and all methodologies are welcome.
