ATCO DRAGWAY TRACK RENTAL AGREEMENT

RENTAL OPTIONS- NEW FOR 2014

Full Day Rental (9:30am- 4:30pm)

Every Car in the rental must pay the \$200 fee before the cars go down the track. At approximately 2:00 pm the settle up with the contractor/renter will occur. At that time the number of cars will be verified and adjustments based on cars will be made. All rentals are priced on a daily basis.

Listed are options for price breaks for larger groups:

Plan A: 1 to 20 cars \$200.00 per car. Rentals must have a minimum of 10 cars \$2000.00

Plan B: 21-30 cars \$180.00 per car (Savings on 30 cars is \$600)

Plan C: 31 to 50 Cars \$160.00 per car (Savings on 50 cars \$1,000.00)

****Over 50 cars please contact the office.**

**Atco reserves the rights to add additional cars to the track rental as GOA these cars are not included/counted in the car count listed above and will be handled by Atco management.

One tech card per car and driver. NO switching drivers. No splitting of rental spots. All crew members must sign the release form.

TRACTION COMPOUND

Dragway is one of the busiest drag strip in the country. We run a regular drag racing event on most Tuesdays, Thursdays, Friday, Saturday Sunday's besides daily track rentals. Therefore the track is well maintained on a consistent basis. For your event the track is sprayed both lanes a full 1320'. Please check the following if you request more: **In certain conditions it may be necessary to touch up the starting line but this is at the starter's discretion.

□ TWO FULL LANES SPRAYED \$1200.00

□ FULL SINGLE LANE (1320FT) One Lane Only \$600.00

 \Box 1/8TH MILE TRACK (660 FT) Single Lane \$300.00

All cars must be safe and able to pass NHRA tech inspection.

Atco Raceway is an NHRA sanctioned track and also governed by the rules and regulations of NJ State Police. ALL NHRA & STATE POLICE RULES MUST BE ADHERED TO.

All racers must have proper credentials and safety equipment or they will be denied the opportunity to race.

WEATHER:

Atco Management will discuss option with renter if inclement weather occurs. *If a weather situation arises you will be notified with an alternate phone number to call for weather conditions and any changes about your rental day.*

TRACK RENTAL RULES AND INFORMATION

<u>Due to NHRA, New Jersey State and Insurance regulations; the following guidelines must be followed at all times</u> <u>during track rentals.</u>

RENTAL DAY--Rentals are from 9:30am to 4:30 pm. Gates open at about 8:30 am. <u>Rental is over at 4:30 sharp. No racer is</u> <u>permitted to race after the cut off time.</u> Your last run should be no later than 4:15. All cars and crew must vacate following the rental day unless agreed upon by management.

TECH CARD: Must be filled out and signed by driver and all crew. Front and Back of tech card must be filled out completely. Each crew person must sign the waiver of the car they are associated with.

ADDITIONS: Track manager reserves the right to add to track rentals.

TECH REMINDERS:

No antifreeze in cars!!!!

Please check that all fluid fittings are tight Carburetors must have hood scoop- air filter, no open carb

Seat Belts- Belts are only valid for two years and <u>must</u> be current

Helmets- Snell 2005 & newer

9.99 & Quicker; Certified Cage, License, Full Face Helmet

7.49 & Quicker: Adv. ET License, Certified Cage, Full Face Helmet, Appropriate Fire Suit, gloves and shoes, Head & Neck Restraints—Hans/ Hybrid

DRIVE IN STREET CARS

Unaltered 2008 OEM model-year and newer production cars running slower than 9.99 and 135 mph DO NOT have to meet the requirements and specifications set by NHRA.

- Except for the following:
 - Convertibles and T-tops must meet the roll-bar and roll-cage requirements.
- <u>ALL drivers must meet the helmet and protective-clothing requirements.</u>

If you require a helmet and fire jacket Atco will rent you these for a minimal cost. Please inquire at tech booth. Jacket must be a SFI 32.A1 and helmet must meet a Snell 2005 or SFI 41.1A min.

RACE DRIVER: Race car must have a number in shoe polish or permanent numbers so the tower can record your runs properly. Racetrack may request a list of drivers attending rental (*Manager will request in advance.*) There is NO BRACKET racing (Dial-ins) available; you are involved in a test and tune. To run No Time you must have N/T clearly written on your car and notify the tower. **ELECTRIC:** Dragway DOES NOT supply electric—please bring your own power/generator.

OILDOWN: *Frequent or flagrant violation of oil downs, you will be asked to leave the facility.* Atco provides a person to handle the clean up. The Atco employee is in charge and you must respect his ability to direct the cleanup and assure track safety. At no time is it permitted for the racer to take it upon their selves to clean up a spillage on the racing surface.

To All Racers, Crew Members and Spectators:

RESTRICTED AREA REGULATIONS:

(Due to strict enforcement by the New Jersey State Police we are adding this to our full rules)

- A Restricted Area is anywhere past the front of the staging lanes including the basin area leading to the burn out box, starting line and return road.
 Any <u>Crew member</u> that wishes to have access to the restricted area must be with a race car and <u>a waiver must be signed before you enter</u> this area. Signing the waiver should be done at tech when the car is inspected with NO EXCEPTIONS!! Once your car makes its run, you must vacate the starting line area either through the staging lanes or by the fenced in area near burn out box grandstands. There is no congregating outside of the fenced in area by anyone! No one is permitted to come to the starting line by way of the return road exit into the pits. Speed Limit is <u>15 mph on the return road</u> and <u>5 mph in the pits</u>. Anyone running out of order or hot lapping will be disqualified from the event and possibly suspended from the track.
 - Photographers must sign waiver in the tower and follow all restricted area regulations.
 - NO Children under the age of 14 are permitted in the restricted area alone. They must be with an adult inside a tow vehicle.
 - No one under the age of 17 is permitted to ride a bicycle, skateboard, scooters, rollerblades, quads or anything that rolls.

Golf Carts

- Must follow all restricted area rules and regulations
- Must be registered with either an NHRA pit vehicle sticker.
- <u>Any adult that occupies a seat next to a minor on a golf cart, quad or any rolling vehicle and permits the minor to steer or control the vehicle in any way will be subject to a warning.</u> Upon a second violation the adult will be subject to immediate suspension of racing or participating privileges.

Please remember that all rules and regulations must be adhered to and are for your safety!
