(a) List the number of years you have been an APPA or regional member in good standing. Each year of membership counts as one point. All years of membership count; however a <u>minimum</u> of three (3) years is required to become a mentor. **This is a base requirement.**

(c) List the year(s) you attended an APPA annual conference. (Attendance at an APPA annual conference counts as one point for each year of attendance.)
