


Good news! We are planning to offer **bus service to SSA-Tucson high school campus** next year for our current Broadway students who would like to attend high school there. We are working with a minivan / bus transportation company. As long as we have at least 6 students, we can start the program with a minivan and add more as needed. The cost will be \$120 per month to be paid from August to May (10 months). The bus will pick up students from the Broadway campus at 7:20 each morning. They will leave the SSA-Tucson campus at 4:20 to allow students to stay after for clubs and tutoring, arriving back at Broadway around 5pm. WHAT TECHNOLOGY TOOLS ARE AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS??

- * **Writing Guide & Dictionary/Thesaurus Tool:** Students will have access to the writing guide tool and the dictionary/thesaurus during the entire writing test.
- * **Scratch Paper:** We will provide scratch paper (plain, lined, or graph) to all students.
- * **Expand/Collapse Passage:** Expand/enlarge a passage for easier readability. These can also be collapsed if needed.
- * **Zoom In/Zoom Out:** Students will be able to enlarge the font and images in the test. Undo zoom in and return the font and images in the test to original size.
- * **Highlighter:** Highlight text in a passage or item.
- * **Line Reader:** Students can track the line he or she is reading.
- * **Mark (Flag) for Review:** Students can Mark an item for review so that it can be easily found later.
- * **Pause/Start:** Students can pause and restart the test throughout the testing session to allow for breaks as needed.
- * **Review Test:** Students can review the test before ending it.
- * **Strikethrough:** Cross out answer options for multiple-choice and multi-select items.
- * **Text-to-Speech Instructions:** Instructions can be read aloud to students. All students will have headphones provided for each testing session.
- * **Tutorial:** There is a short video about each item type and how to respond that we will show students prior to the test beginning.

MATH

- Multiple Choice

ELA - Writing & Reading

- Writing From Sources
- Two Part Questions
- Multiple Choice
- Select Multiple Answers
- Finding Evidence
- Short Answer/Essay

- Ensure that your child gets plenty of rest the night before the tests.
- Ensure that your child gets a healthy breakfast.
- Be sure that your child arrives on time to school each day.

- Leave your child an encouraging note that they can read just before they get started.
