#### **FABRIC AND SUPPLY REQUIREMENTS**

Holiday Banner Panel Batting (optional)

Backing Fabric: 2/3 yard (optional)

Trim: 3 yards (for 9 piece banner. If you use more pieces, you'll need a longer piece of trim)

Holiday Banner Alphabet Templates Reversed

Fusible Webbing

Fabric Scraps for Letters

Additional Trims as Desired

#### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions first before cutting.

#### Quilting (optional)

Layer back, batting and banner panel and quilt together.

#### Assembly

- 1. Cut the banner pieces out from the panel using pinking or decorative blade.
- 2. Trace the letters you would like to use onto the fusible webbing, making sure that the letters are reversed.
- 3. Iron the fusible webbing onto the back of the letter fabric(s) and cut out the letters. Iron the letters onto the banner pieces.
- 4. Place the right side of the banner pieces on the back side of the trim and stitch into place leaving tails of trim on each side of the banner. Use as many banner pieces as you desire.
- 5. Decorate banner as desired. We have added gems, doilies, yo-yos, tulle, assorted trims and buttons.
