You may also want to include a reference to your business's credit terms, such as penalties for late payment. This is at your own discretion. While it might help to reference this, it may be off-putting to a large business that has other potential supplier options. Applying the correct VAT rate is essential, and it can be a difficult process if you are supplying a variety of products or services. If you are not charging the correct rate of VAT, you may be subject to interest and penalties should the matter be uncovered during a Revenue audit.
