Payment Methods

Please make cheques payable to Isle of Man Post Office.

All postal applications must be made by cheque or postal order and not cash.

Payment at the counters can be made using: Cheque, Cash, Debit Cards or Postal orders.

Dishonoured Cheques

If a cheque for a licence is dishonoured, the licence will be void from the date of issue and the vehicle will become unlicensed.

Identity Requirements

Duplicate registration certificate and Vehicle Licences will only be provided when the signature of the current registered keeper is supplied.

If any one acquires a vehicle without either the registration certificate or the licence then the Licensing Office will have to write to the previous registered keeper before another one can be issued. They will be allowed 14 days to respond. You may be asked for proof of identity before a duplicate is issued.
