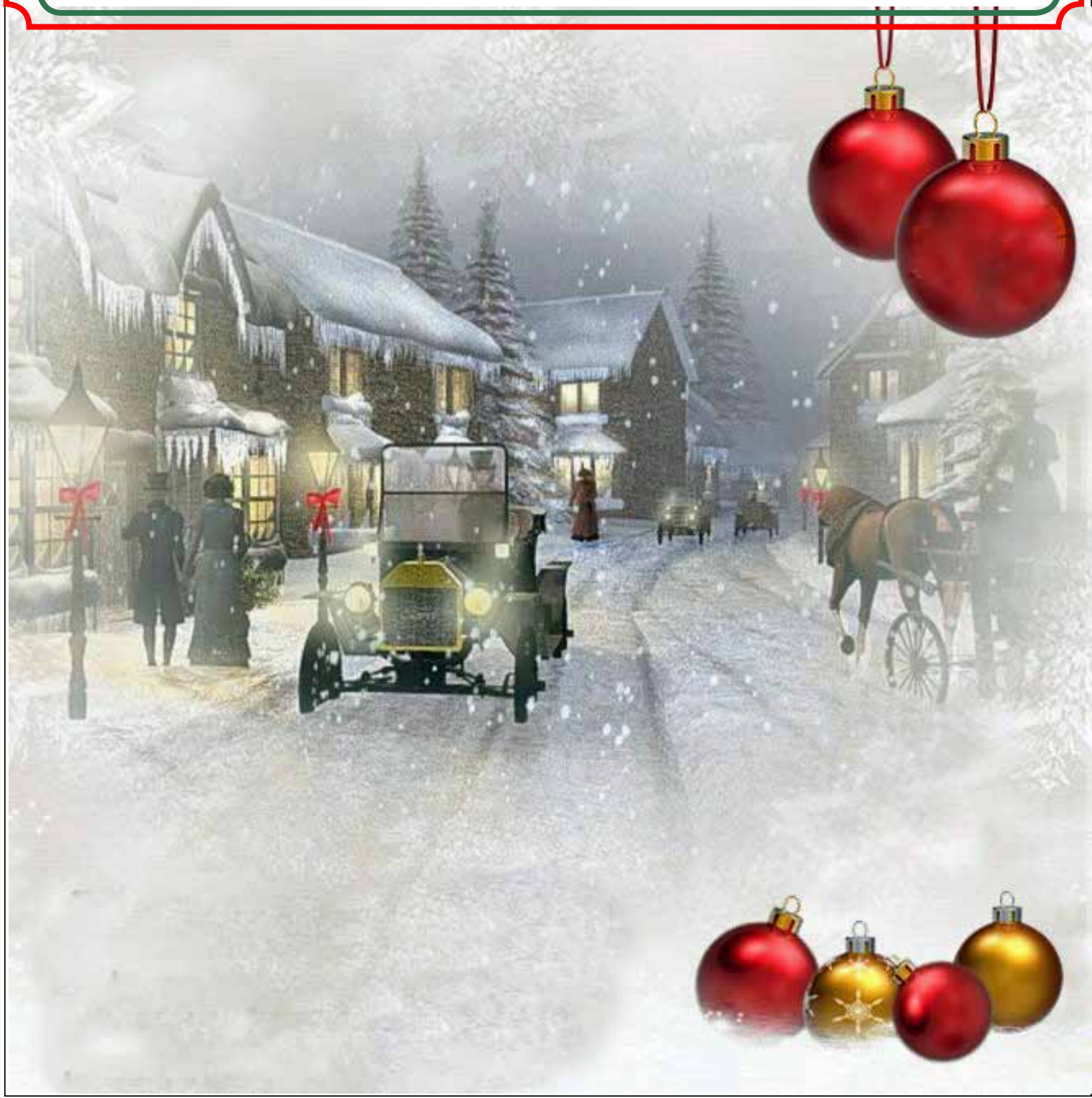


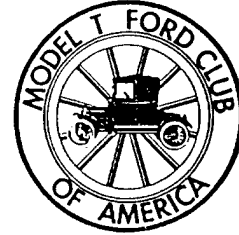
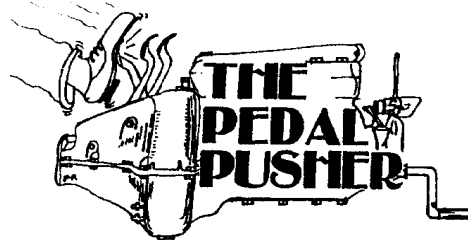

New Business: The slate of officers will be voted on at the December meeting and published in the January newsletter.

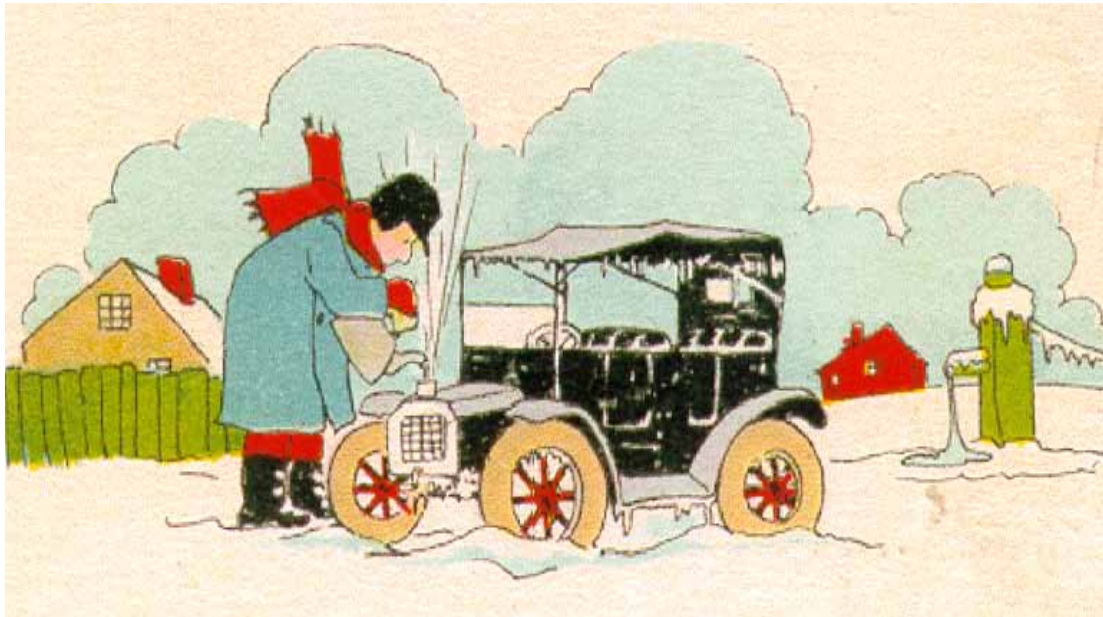
Meeting was adjourned at 7:29 PM.
