Description of the location

An old Victorian House, previously a doctor's residence for many years. A new extension was added in 1989. The Coach House was converted and used as an annexe for in-house services in 1995. In 2008 the loft was converted to provide office space for our secretaries and audit team providing extra consulting rooms downstairs for the GP Registrars and Medical Students. The building retains its original homely feel within surrounding gardens and a large car park to the rear for staff and patients. We have a front door access which has a ramp with a rail for disabled access as well as steps. An adjacent side entrance is equipped with a ramp and a bell to attract assistance. There is a reserved parking space for disabled patients and a reserved ambulance parking area. Patient services can always be provided on ground floor level. We do have two consulting rooms on the first floor that are available when necessary for those patients able to access them. Access to the Coach House annexe is on ground floor level. All consulting rooms are fully equipped for consulting and treatment room medical and nursing purposes.
