Event management

Event overview

The Dressage Championships are run on an alternative hosting basis between Waitara Pony Club and Hawera Pony Club. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish with a maximum number of four riders to a team. Any composite teams must be approved by the organising committee. Teams may consist of riders in at least two of the four classes. Team scoring will be allocated by placings in the event e.g. First place = 10 points, Second place = 9 points etc to Tenth place = 1 point. The winning team will be the team with the highest points on the day.


