

Consortium Agreement

In order to allow undergraduate students to have all units counted toward Title IV fund eligibility and in-school deferment, Pacific Oaks College will enter into Consortium Agreements with eligible institutions under the provisions of Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. Pacific Oaks College will act as the primary school with participating community colleges as long as the units executed at a two-year institution are transferable and we have an Articulation Agreement documentation with. All schools that Pacific Oaks College has agreements with are listed on the web via the Admissions office. Please reference the Articulation Agreement page.

As the primary school, **Pacific Oaks College** will certify agreements on a student by student basis, confirming the student as enrolled in a degree seeking program. Pacific Oaks College will award and disburse Title IV funds in accordance with the enrollment status as determined by the total units at both schools and the total of tuition and fees at both schools. In-school deferments will be processed in accordance with the enrollment status as determined by the total units enrolled.

The student will be responsible for initiating the Agreement and getting appropriate signatures and documentation of enrollment at the Secondary School. **Proof of registration from the Secondary School must accompany this Consortium Agreement.** Courses that you're registered for must be transferable to Pacific Oaks College. Any questions regarding this should be directed to the Registrar's office.

The Secondary school will certify that they are an eligible institution under the provisions of Title IV and confirm that the student is not receiving financial aid for the current award year at that institution. The Secondary School will identify the course(s) being taken by the student that are part of an eligible program and appropriate for the educational objective of the student. Additional information will be provided regarding the total amount of tuition and fees applicable to the Pell cost of attendance charged the student for those courses identified. Upon request, the Secondary School will forward enrollment and satisfactory progress information to the Primary School.

A separate Agreement must be executed for each term.
