 For students currently living in the United States, bank statement dates must be within six months of quarter of entry. For students living outside the United States, bank statement dates must be within twelve months of the quarter of entry.
- Photocopies and facsimiles of signatures and bank statements are acceptable.
- Sign and date the statement of responsibility section.
- All portions of this International Student Declaration of Finances must be completed for issuance of an I-20A (F-1 students) or DS-2019 (J-1 students).
