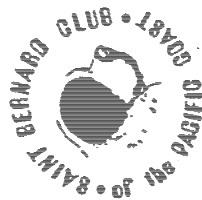

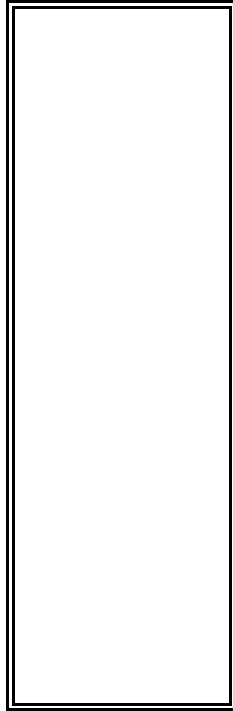

The Sacramento-Sierra Saint Bernard Club will hold two SBCA sanctioned weight pulls for St. Bernards only, on Thursday, April 24 and Friday, April 25, 2014. The pull will be on carpet, outdoors. Loaner harnesses will be available. Weight pull judges are to be determined.

Each dog MUST be at least six months old and have an AKC registration or ILP/PAL number as a Saint Bernard. The classes may be divided: 139 pounds and under and 140 pounds and over. Entries are taken at the weigh in. Entry fee is \$20.00 except puppies that are 6 months old and under 12 months old, which will be \$10.00. Entry forms will be available at the Show Secretary's table during conformation judging.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.** The Treasurer will add a collection fee of \$25.00 plus bank fees to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors or agent may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.
- CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted.
- PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6)
- DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
- DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE CARE** and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume the responsibility in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
- PUPPIES AND DOGS NOT ENTERED** in the show will not be permitted on the show premises.
- An **AGENT** is a person 18 years or older, other than an owner or co-owner, designated by the owner or co-owner to be handler or, and responsible for, the dog at the show. Agents' names may be followed by the initials which represent their AKC-recognized professional group affiliation or certification. Persons seeking the services of such an agent should familiarize themselves with the requirements for professional group membership or certifications.
- OFA and CERF numbers** will be included in the catalog if specified with entry form.
- BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Event Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the entry fee for Obedience and/or Rally will be refunded. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
