Financial aid operates on a nine-month budget that includes direct and indirect costs. Direct costs are billed on the tuition bill and are included in “Step 1” inside this brochure. Below is a list of indirect costs that students MAY encounter while attending MSOE. Please note that indirect costs are based on estimates. Students can use these estimates to help budget accordingly for costs associated with attending MSOE for the nine-month academic year, as well as determine how much to consider borrowing through PLUS or alternative loans.

The MSOE Book Purchase Policy allows students to charge book purchases made at the MSOE Bookstore to their MSOE student account and to be billed for those charges on the next monthly invoice. In addition, several courses have a textbook rental option. If a textbook rental option is available for a course, it will indicate on the shelf tag that a rental option is available. A credit card is needed to secure a textbook rental, but the rental cost can be charged to MSOE student accounts. This program is available during the two weeks before the quarter begins through Friday of the first week of the quarter. This policy includes the purchase/rental of books and supplies only. Students need only present their MSOE ID to the Bookstore cashier when purchasing/renting books.

Bills are made available for **students** to view online at my.msoe.edu. Students will be billed the difference between their accepted financial aid and the quarter’s direct costs. The amount billed is due by the Monday of the third week of each quarter. Please note that student loan awards will not be

included on the initial bill if the promissory notes have yet to be signed or the entrance counseling has yet to be completed. Please visit studentloans.gov to complete these steps.

Account balances can be viewed and credit card payments processed online at my.msoe.edu. Cash or check payments can be made in person at the Student Accounts Office located in CC-437. There is a drop box in which payment may be left. For online payments, MSOE accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. The Helping Everyone to Learn and Pay (H.E.L.P.) payment plan option creates smaller, interest-free monthly payments instead of one large payment per term. A convenience fee (2.75% of transaction amount) will be added to credit card payments.
