is developing the 2015 exhibition schedule. We invite emerging and professional visual artists to submit images of recent original artwork for consideration by our selection committee. From the work selected, The Arts Center Gallery mounts four exhibitions in our 2,000 square foot gallery each year.

Submitting artists are considered for solo, two-person or group exhibitions based on interpretive or conceptual themes. Strong preference is given to work within one series or concept.

Curatorial proposals are encouraged from those interested in designing and mounting an exhibition of artwork other than their own.

Those who have shown in solo or group exhibitions (more than one artwork) in The Arts Center Gallery within the past three years CANNOT be considered for this review process. This restriction DOES NOT include appearance in our annual member or juried exhibitions.

Submissions received after March 31 will not be considered for review. Selection notification will be completed June 2013. Submissions are reviewed anonymously by a select group of local arts professionals. Incomplete entries will not be reviewed.

Submission Guidelines

- **Entry Form**

- **A CD of 10 Images**

of original recent artwork. Images must be saved at 300 ppi, 6 inches on largest side. Save each file as last name_first name_# in submission (example: Doe_Jane_1.jpg) CD must be Mac Compatible.

- **Typed/ Printed Image List**

Must include artwork title, medium, dimensions, and date created. Numbered images on the CD should correspond to the image list.

- **Typed/ Printed Artist Statement**

- **Typed/ Printed Artist Resume**

- **DVD (optional)**

For artists submitting installations/ new media. Do not exceed 10 minutes in length. Label with Name, Title of Work and Date of Completion. DVD Must be Mac Compatible.

- **Typed/ Printed Curatorial Proposal (optional).**

For those interested in designing and mounting an exhibition of artwork other than their own. Names and images of each artist must be included. Not to exceed 20 images, including details. Include appropriate support material and contact information.

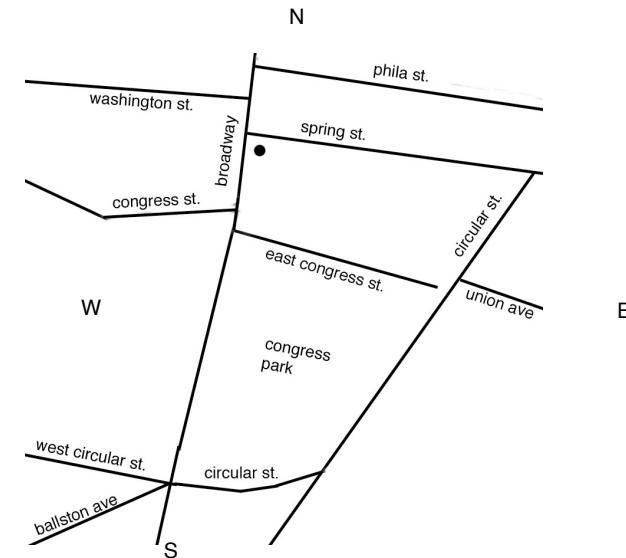
- **SASE (self addressed stamped envelope, optional)**

If you would like your materials returned to you. Please include an appropriately stamped envelope that is large enough to fit your materials in, otherwise materials will not be returned.

Please Note: Saratoga Arts does not cover the cost of shipping or handling at this time. All artwork submitted must be available for exhibition. All original prints must be signed and labeled appropriately in limited editions of 15 or less. (example: 1/15)
