



Fall 2013 DIRECT TRANSFER ADMISSIONS June 5, 2013 – August 7, 2013

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: Transfer applicants with at least 30 college credits completed must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.00 from all postsecondary institutions attended and be *CUNY Skills-Certified. Students wishing to transfer into the Forensic Science program must have a 2.50 GPA in science and mathematics courses credited toward the major. Transfer students educated outside of the United States CANNOT apply through Direct Transfer Admissions at John Jay College.

*CUNY SKILLS REQUIREMENTS (PLEASE REVIEW THESE REQUIREMENTS CAREFULLY!)

ALL students must be skills-certified in reading, writing and mathematics. Applicants to all four-year colleges must have completed at least one college-level, 3 credit course in English and mathematics with a grade of "C" or better or must demonstrate college-level readiness based on SAT, ACT or New York Regents test scores. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

#1: TRANSCRIPTS

• Bring in all applicable official (sealed in envelopes) transcripts to the Office of Admissions. Provide proof of high school graduation. Acceptable documents: **original** high school diploma, or **official** high school transcript or official GED diploma with scores.

YOU MUST BRING IN ALL OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM ALL INSTITUTIONS ATTENDED BEFORE AN ADMISSIONS DECISION IS DETERMINED.

#2: APPLICATION PROCESS

- An admissions counselor will review all transcripts to determine eligibility. If you meet the college's requirements as a fully accepted direct transfer student, you will complete an online direct transfer application in the Office of Admissions.
- Upon acceptance, you will have to pay a non-refundable application fee of \$70.00 by submitting a check or money order made payable to UAPC.

(Application Fee is waived for students currently enrolled at a CUNY college for Spring 2013.)

ADMISSIONS FOLLOW-UP

Upon acceptance, please allow up to 2 weeks for your transfer credits to be evaluated. You must provide immunization documents to the Health Office and pay a \$100 seat deposit before you can register. For more information, visit http://www.ijay.cuny.edu/transfer to complete the enrollment steps.
