Passport Application Information

Go to Walgreens and get your picture taken 2x2inches in color. Walgreens will know what to do.

Make an appointment at the Post Office or go the Library Center on south Campbell in Springfield.

Fill out ahead of time (but do not sign just yet) paperwork DS-11 and DS -64

Bring old passport if you have one or birth certificate, and bring driver's license.

You must know your social security number (bring card - better to be safe than sorry).

If under the age of 16, bring both parents (might want to call first).

Step 1: Apply Early

Apply for your passport several months before your trip. Also, know your expiration date. Many countries require passports to have at least 6 months validity at the time of entry.

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How long is a passport valid and is it true that it needs to have at least 6 months of validity remaining?

If you were **age 16 or older** when your passport was issued, your passport is valid for **10 years.**

If you were **age 15 or younger** when your passport was issued, your passport is valid for **5 years.**

The *Issue Date* of your passport can be found on the data page of your Passport Book or on the front of your Passport Card.

The passport must be valid for six months past the traveling dates.
