1098-T Description:

The IRS allows colleges and universities to report either payments received (Box 1) or amounts billed (Box 2) for qualified education expenses. Cedarville University reports amounts billed (Box 2).

Electronic invoices are avilable to all students. Fall semester charges are included in the July invoice, and Spring semester charges are included in the January invoice. This means that you are billed for Fall of 2013 during the current calendar year (2013), so charges for Spring semester 2014 will appear on next year's form.
