Peewee and Midget Boys National Tournaments will be held August 4th to 10th 2013 in Whitby, Ontario at the OLA's Lacrosse Festival. Bantam Boys will be held August 2nd to 8th in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Bantam Girls, Midget Girls and Junior Women's Nationals will be held in Halifax, Nova Scotia from July 23rd to 28th 2013.

A team in each division will be selected from all eligible Ontario players. Teams will be chosen from a series of open selection camps held in the Spring of 2013.

The OLA Minor Box Provincial Coaches Selection Committee is currently taking applications for <u>COACHING</u>, <u>GENERAL MANAGER</u> and <u>TRAINER/EQUIPMENT MANAGER</u> positions. Each team will require a general manager, 2-3 coaches, and a trainer/equipment manager. All positions are volunteer positions.

The Head Coach and the Assistant Coaches of each team must be fully certified under the National Coaching Certification Program at a full Level 2 or Competitive Introduction. Certification must accompany resume.

- Attendance and participation at special coaching seminars/meetings
- Ability to attend Identification Camps, Invitational and Main Selection Camp in Spring 2013
- Ability to provide constructive feedback for player's future development
- Knowledge and understanding of potential game adjustments and facilitating them during the course of the competition
- Ability to work with OLA approved evaluators and jointly recognize and select quality lacrosse players who will be successful in the 2013 CLA National Tournament
