RECORD BOOK ASSEMBLY-Use the Record Book Cover provided by the 4-H Office or the cover available from the National 4-H Supply Catalog. A flat binder with extension brackets or loose rings may be used to protect the cover provided by the 4-H Office. If using the covers provided by the 4-H Office be sure to use metal fasteners, loose rings or flat binders with metal extension brackets to secure the records. When using flat binders members are to put their name, club and county in the upper right hand corner of the cover front. The cover provided by the 4-H Office is inserted inside of the flat binder. The cover may be cut in the center before placing in the binder in order to accommodate a thick record book.

Fasten Record Book Securely.

DO NOT:

Include registration or pedigree papers.

Include Lamb Show or Fair ribbons or other scrapbook items.

Use plastic covers on record pages.

Use 3-ring binders.
