One student from each of Greater Clark's three high schools (Charlestown High School, Jeffersonville High School, and New Washington High School) will receive \$1,000.00 in scholarship assistance.

The scholarship amount will be provided in the following manner:

\$500.00 will be paid to the college the student will attend at the time of enrollment. **\$500.00** will be paid to the college the student attends at the time that the student provides proof that he/she has been accepted into the college's School of Education.

This scholarship is given in memory of Dr. David M. Pulliam who served as the Superintendent of Schools for the Greater Clark County School Corporation from 1995 until his retirement in June 2003. Dr. Pulliam was instrumental in the formation of the GCCS Educational Foundation. This Foundation awards monies to eligible Greater Clark students for college tuition assistance and provides funds for teacher mini-grants and student cultural development activities.

Dr. Pulliam died on February 1, 2004.
