Overview of Activities...

5 to 7 year olds: Tubman Learners will review basic math, phonics, and language arts skills through games, language experience charts, and lots of cultural expressions – music, movement, arts and crafts. Each two-week session will end with a tournament, display of journal writing and cultural expressions.

8 to 10 year olds: Garvey Learners will play games with each other for appropriate social skill development. They will maintain a journal and participate in lots of cultural expressions – music, movement, arts and crafts. Each two-week session will end with a tournament, display of journal writing and cultural expressions.

11 to 13 year olds: Banneker Learners will spend two days a week "in the field" visiting African American historical sites throughout the DMV and two days at camp reviewing, writing, and discussing their travel experiences while researching the next experience. Each two-week session will end with a presentation about their travels.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Behavior Expectations

ACAS Summer Camp staff expects that all of the campers will be on their best behavior daily.

If a camper is having challenges on a particular day, we will attempt to help the camper reach a solution as quickly as possible. If a camper has challenges with expected rules or following directions of the staff, parents will be notified immediately.

The course of action below will be followed in normal circumstances:

1. Warning	For a specific unacceptable behavior
2. Time Out	With a warning of future consequences for repeated behavior
3. Time Out	With a warning and/or write up for repeated behavior in file and parent notified upon pick up
4. Time Out	With a call to parent or guardian and a write up. Discuss corrective action and consequences for future incidents with parent upon pick up
5. ICS (In Camp	1 scheduled day away from the program and/or the
Suspension)	remainder of the day depending on the infraction. Meeting with the Director.
Attend Camp with Parent	After a day in ICS, if behavior continues, parent must spend the next day of camp with their child.

However, extreme behaviors that put a child or those around them in danger, or several or repeated offenses in one day may accelerate this process and will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Extreme behaviors include, but are not limited to: Physical attacks

such as hitting, biting, spitting, kicking, etc., abusive language, disrespect to staff (verbally or physically by parent or child), and leaving the program area without permission.

Electronic and Other Personal Items

The ACAS Summer Camp requests that you do not permit your child to bring personal items such as portable electronic games (Play stations, Game Boys, etc.), or other electronic items (IPods, portable cd players, cell phones). ACAS Summer Camp will not bear responsibility for any lost, stolen or broken items. We have designed our camp to keep your child busy, engaged and entertained. If you or your child needs to be in contact in case of emergency or for urgent matters, a camp cellular phone number will be provided to you.

Non-Prescription Applications

If you feel it is necessary to send with your child non-prescription applications, specific written instructions must be included and your child must be capable of administering the applications while an adult observes. We are unable to assist your child in the use of any of the topical applications listed below.

Pictures, Photographs, Videos

Please be advised that ACAS Summer Camp may use pictures that show our campers in the classroom, on field trips, at lunch or recess for camp related business on our website, inside the camp facility, on flyers or other related promotional material. If you object to ACAS Summer Camp using pictures or videos that include your child, please indicate so on the general consent form at the end of the policies and procedures.

Sign In and Sign Out

Participants in ACAS Summer Camp must be signed in and out daily by a parent or other authorized person. This is done by signing your full name and time of drop off and pick-up on the form located at entrance of the Summer Camp facility. A child enrolled in the ACAS Summer Camp will only be released to the persons specifically authorized in the camp registration forms. For the safety of your children, anyone other than the registering parent/guardian will be required to show a valid photo ID at the time of pick up or drop off. If only one person has the sole legal custody of a child, then legal custody papers must be on file.

Snacks and Lunches

We have opted to NOT participate in the free breakfast and lunch program because in our opinion it is not a good option for children with food allergies and/or dietary restrictions (i.e., vegetarian). Therefore, please send a healthy lunch, water, and a snack with your child.

Campers enrolled in Before and After Camp should also bring an additional snack clearly labeled for BEFORE and/or AFTER CARE. Campers must bring food items that are non-perishable and do not require warming in an oven or microwave. Due to allergies, campers are not allowed to share lunches.
