## Washington State USBC Association Mixed Tournament Rules

1. ELIGIBILITY: All bowlers must be members of the United States Bowling Congress, having obtained membership through a local association within the jurisdiction of the Washington State USBC Association (WSUSBC). Non-USBC members may establish eligibility by purchasing an associate membership. Nonresidents not showing proof of membership obtained through a local jurisdiction of the WSUSBC will be required to purchase an associate membership.
2. AVERAGE REQUIREMENT/VERIFICATION: Entrants will use their highest USBC or CTF certified league yearbook or association average based on the 2012-2013 season with a minimum of 21 games, including summer league average. If the bowlers have no qualifying average from 2012-2013 than they may enter using their highest 2013-2014 average for 12 or more games at the time of bowling. USBC Rules $\mathbf{3 1 9 ( d )}$ and $319(e)$ apply in this tournament, all others bowl scratch. Average verification must be submitted prior to bowling if a bowler's confirmation has an asterisk next to his/her name. Failure to use the proper average or to make correction prior to, or before, completion of the first game of any event shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base prize winnings on submitted average if higher. Entrants without a verified average will automatically be assigned an average of 230. USBC Rule 319a (2) does not apply, Bowler must use average with hand established.
3. TEAM CAPTAIN RESPONSIBILITY: The acceptance of an entry by tournament management constitutes an agreement by the captain on behalf of the team to abide by all rules of USBC and the tournament. See USBC Rule 304.
4. BOWLER RESPONSIBILITY: Per USBC Rule 319a-3, it is the bowler's responsibility to make sure correct average is being used.
5. RESERVATIONS/CLOSING DATE: Phone reservations will be accepted until June 1, 2014. Completed entry forms and fees must be received in full in the Tournament Manager's office. The closing date for entries is June 6, 2014, unless extended. All entry fees must accompany entry form.
6. ENTRY FEES/PAYOUTS/RETURNED CHECK CHARGES: $\$ 120.00$ for 4-person Team; $\$ 60.00$ for Doubles; $\$ 30.00$ for Singles; (optional) All Events (scratch and/or handicap), $\$ 5.00$ each. Prize fund $-\$ 14.00$; lineage and expenses $-\$ 16.00$ per person, per event. Payout 1 in 6 ( 1 in 12 in All Events). Prize fund will be returned $100 \%$. Awards and USBC championship chevrons will be awarded to the handicap champions in each event. No entry fee will be returned after acceptance of assigned scheduled time. A $\$ 35.00$ fee plus bank fees will be charged for any checks returned by the banks, credit unions, etc. For any prize checks that need to be re-printed due to being lost, ruined, etc., a fee of $\$ 35$ will be charged for the stop payment fee at the bank.
7. HANDICAP: $90 \%$ of 230 .
8. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: The tournament will consist of a mixed team event (2 USBC MALE MEMBERS \& $\mathbf{2}$ USBC FEMALE MEMBERS), mixed doubles (1 USBC MALE MEMBER AND 1 USBC FEMALE MEMBER) and singles. Multiple participation is allowed in the team event as long as 2 players in the lineup are changed. Multiple participation is allowed in the doubles event, but one person in the lineup must be changed. Multiple participation is allowed in singles. USBC rules 315 b and 315 d will apply. The first time bowled in each event counts towards your All Events. Cash only once in Singles.
9. SUBSTITUTIONS/LINEUP CHANGES: Changes in lineups are not allowed; rule 324 a does not apply. Substitutions may be made up to 1 (one) hour before time of bowling, but substitute must take lineup position of absent bowler. Averages for substitute bowlers must be listed in a yearbook or certified by the local association manager or league secretary at the time of bowling; otherwise, bowler will be entered scratch. Substitutes will not be required to reimburse the original entrants with the entry fee paid, nor will they be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or trophy they may win.
10. PROFESSIONAL BOWLER ASSOCIATION (PBA \& PWBA) MEMBERS: No Doubles team or 4-player team may include more than one member of" or the Professional Bowlers Association [PBA].
11. SPECIAL PRIZES: A special prize of $\$ 25$ each will be awarded to the man and woman rolling the highest scratch game of the tournament. A special prize of $\$ 50$ each will be awarded to the man and woman rolling the highest scratch series of the tournament.
12. ERRORS/SCORES LOST: All claims of error must be submitted in writing to the WSUSBC Association Manager within 48 hours after the bowler or team has bowled.
