I. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. The recipient must be a certified teacher in another field other than deaf education, a college student currently enrolled in deaf education, or a student enrolled in an interpreting training program.
- B. The recipient must agree to enroll as a full-time student (12 hours or more) at an accredited college or university.
- C. The scholarship recipient must have demonstrated exceptional scholarship, citizenship, and leadership capabilities.

D. The scholarship check will be made to the college or university in which the recipient is enrolled.

II. SCHOLARSHIP PROCEEDURES

- A. The scholarship committee is composed of community members not affiliated with the Texas School for the Deaf or the Regional Day School for the Deaf. The committee members will not know any of the applicants which will prevent unintentional bias.
- B. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1 of the current year.
- C Selection will be made by the committee no later than May 1 of the current year. Winners will be announced immediately.

III. TAPED SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The criteria to be used by the scholarship committee for evaluating application will be a numerical point value system based on the following factors.
