### Medication at School

Medford School District 549C complies with Oregon State Law requiring that ALL medi-  
cations administered at school have a signed authorization form from the parents giving  
specific instructions for administration. This includes over-the-counter medications such as  
cough drops or Tylenol. Forms are available in the school office.

1. Whenever possible, medication should be given at times other than school hours.
2. A permission form must be filled out by the parent/guardian to administer medica-  
tions
3. The medication must be supplied in the **original** labeled container.
4. Students cannot transport their own medications.
5. Changes to the medication must be made by the parents in writing.

The label must include: your student’s name, name of medication, amount of dosage, route  
to be administered, time to be given, any special instructions and physician name (for pre-  
scription medication). A current pharmacy label meets this requirement.

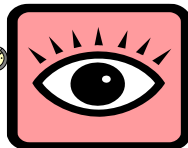

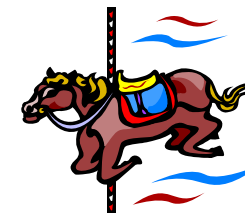
## **BUDGET COMMITTEE VACANCY**
