# G.A.T.E./Honors English 1 Application Form

### **Course Overview**

The G.A.T.E./Honors English 1 course is offered to students capable of enjoying, profiting from, and contributing to a demanding advanced academic course. This course is designed to service the needs of students who exceed the standards, and through their state test scores, writing samples, and English class grades, have proven themselves as high achievers who exhibit critical and analytical thinking, as well as writing skills necessary for an Honors English course.

The course is open to all who meet the admission requirements and is not limited to G.A.T.E identified students or to those currently enrolled in an honors English class.

# **Advantages of an Honors Class:**

Students who participate in the Honors/AP program during their years at BUHS profit in several ways:

- 1. Extra high school grade point for Honors English 9 and 10 and AP 11 and AP 12.
- 2. Intense literary study and in-class essay writing as preparation for the Advanced Placement exam in AP 11 and AP 12 courses and for college English courses.
- 3. College credits (at most colleges) earned with a score of 3, 4, or 5 on the AP English exams given in May of the junior and senior years. As a result, students may be exempted with credit from introductory college English courses during their freshman year.

# **Course Requirements**

Because of limits to the number of students who can take the course, and in order to maintain the rigor necessary for an Honors course, all students seeking entry to G.A.T.E./Honors English 1 must meet the following qualifications:

- Have scored "Advanced" on the ELA section of the CST's the previous academic year. (Proficient may be considered.)
- Read at or above grade level.
- Have received grades of "A" or "B" in English courses the previous 2 semesters.
