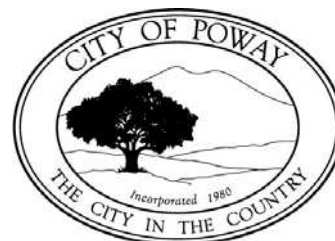

THANK YOU FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE RENDEZVOUS IN POWAY 2013! LISTED BELOW ARE RULES TO ENSURE AUTHENTICITY AND SAFETY IN THE ENCAMPMENT AREA.

ENCAMPMENT RULES

- ⇒ This is to re-create the pre-1890 era by day and night. All visible gear in the encampment area is to be reasonably authentic in material and design. You are also required to dress in period outfits at all times. Modern equipment, ice chests, etc. must be covered.
- ⇒ Appropriate attire is required. Each person must wear shorts or pants and a shirt.
- ⇒ No smoking is permitted while children are present during school tours on Thursday and Friday. If you smoke, please use the park's designated smoking area located by the restrooms behind the Hamburger Factory.
- ⇒ No drinking alcohol during the event hours or campfire held on Friday night. Members of the public will be in close proximity of the encampment area and children will be present.
- ⇒ Loading and unloading time is limited to one hour in the encampment area. Drive once to your campsite, unload your gear, park your car, then come back to setup your equipment. Unloading and setup must be conducted before or after event hours.
- ⇒ No unauthorized firing demos. All firing demos must be preapproved by Old Poway Park staff.
- ⇒ All firearms must be inspected immediately upon arrival to the Rendezvous. Firearms must be brought to the Saloon and inspected by Steve Johnson, Doc Holiday.

RULES FOR DOGS AT RENDEZVOUS

- ⇒ No vicious or aggressive dogs will be allowed at the Rendezvous. If your dog has a tendency to bite then please do not bring it to the Rendezvous.
- ⇒ Dogs must be leashed at all times and kept within your own campsite.
- ⇒ You are expected to clean up after your dog.
- ⇒ Any owner who does not obey the rules for dogs will be expelled from Rendezvous per San Diego Municipal Code 63.0102 (b) 2 and 63.670.
